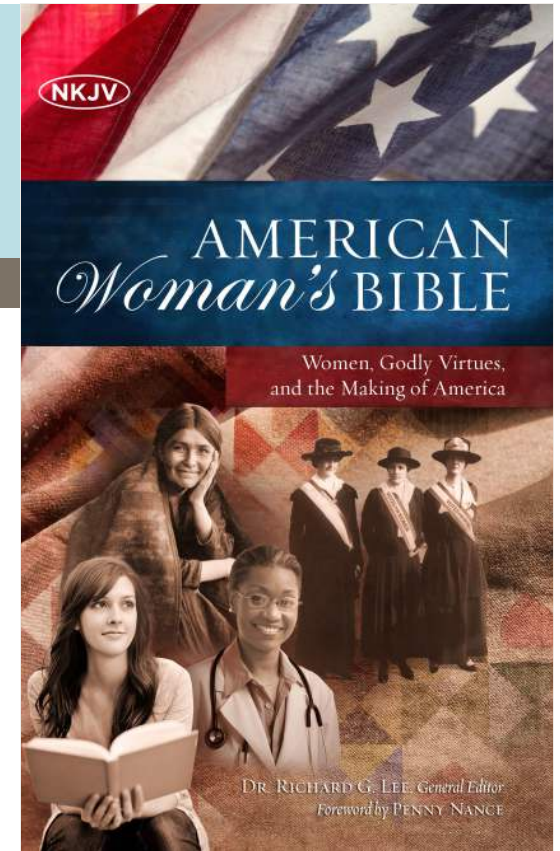
- From our nation's beginnings through current day, this Bible – in exploring 250 courageous and heroic American women – will encourage women to make an impact for God and forge a legacy of their own.

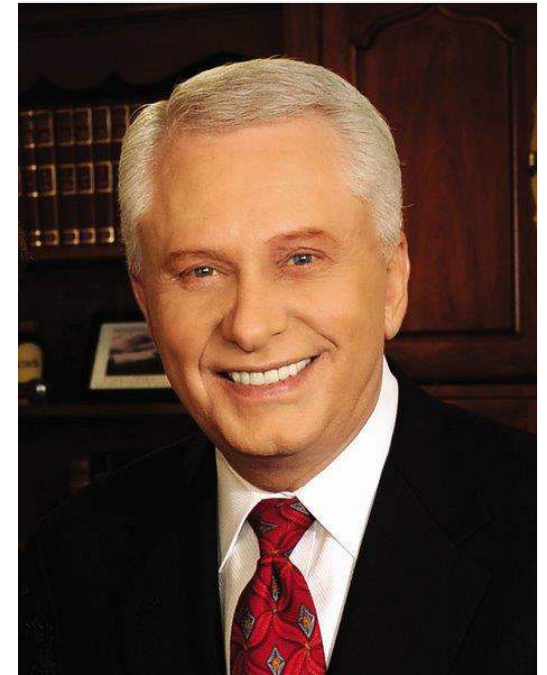
WHO IS DR. RICHARD LEE?:
