WHAT IS IT?

A country boy from rural Tennessee, Joey Lankford had what a lot of people spend their lives chasing - the nice house, the nice family and the nice salary, running the family business in affluent suburban Nashville. But with that 'nice life', comes something else – a hunger for more. Drained, empty, and frustrated trying to keep up and keep it together, this man of action and deep faith left absolutely everything his family of six knew behind and moved them to South Africa. But, for the most part, they struggle with what relevance that faith has right now. As a lot of the old southern preachers say, people tend to view faith as fire insurance for when

they die. When they do that, they fail to recognize the fullness of the Kingdom that is offered to us all right now. Our marriages can be different, our kids can be different, our faith can be relevant. And, you don't have to move to Africa. You can put your faith to action right there in your own neighborhood. We just have to take ourselves off of center stage and put God there. My hope is that, in hearing what God has done with our mustard seed of faith, others might pay a little more attention to those promptings of the Spirit and take that first step towards surrender and freedom. Because God doesn't waste a thing and the choices we have an opportunity to make, every single day, have eternal consequences."

"So many people are stuck. They're tired. They're where I was. They want more, but they aren't sure what 'more' is and where and how to get it. It's my prayer that this book will help people understand that true fulfillment is awaiting them on the other side of surrender."
